Sandy,

Given that these events occurred well over a year ago it is very unlikely that you would be able to get any kind of restraining order against him and will likely only be perceived as a frantic bitter ex-spouse which will not help your case when there are truly meritorious issues that come up in the future because they have been soured by past un-meritorious actions that go nowhere.

As for having criminal charges pressed against him, these are not done by criminal attorneys. This is done by the calling the police and filing a report. Again, given that these events occurred over a year ago there will be a lot of difficulty for the police to substantiate charges and doing so may actually harm any future meritorious claims you may have by filing belated criminal charges.

As it relates to your desire to sue him for infliction of emotional distress. This is normally done as part of the divorce litigation. Now that the divorce is over you would have to speak with an attorney who specializes in plaintiff injury lawsuits to see if you still have a case. This is not the sort of thing we do here.

But I can tell you that there is a 2-year statute of limitations which means time is running out. Also, you need to prove damages which means you need to be diagnosed by a doctor, that doctor needs to say your emotional injuries were caused by him and that you are receiving treatment. But you need to speak with an attorney that specializes in this sort of law and we do not.

Regardless both Kim and I think it is very important that you seek professional help to help you deal with the abuse you suffered so that you can better focus on the things you can change with the assistance of your lawyers and find serenity and acceptance of the things that you cannot change right now. We are working on your fraud/mistake motion. I'm waiting for the information to come in from the MVC and for the trial transcript to come in and see what gems might pop up. Once we have all of that I can start the tedious process of connecting the dots and try to reopen a few things.
